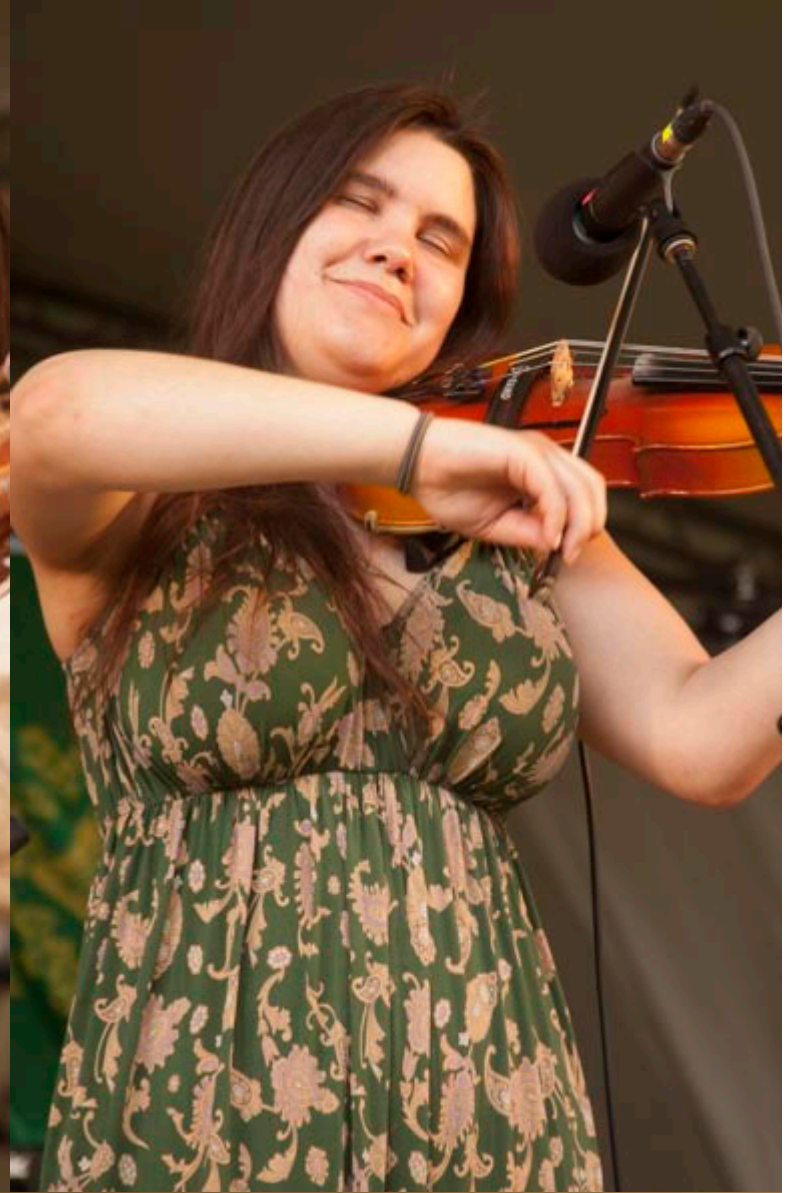


# Fiddlehead Soup

There's something about Fiddlehead Soup that seems to connect with people from all ages and walks of life.

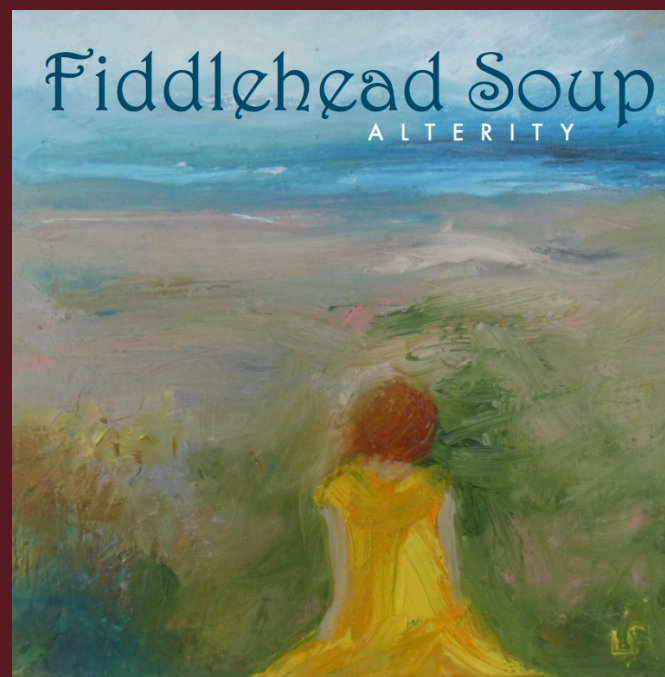
